**Price Gouging Experience:**

On [REDACTED] 2014, I was admitted to [REDACTED] for [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. My charge for approx. 4 hrs in the [REDACTED] >\$15,000. When reviewing my itemized statement I saw a \$6000 CT scan,(that I had subsequently for \$500 somewhere else) & were they kidding, \$1024.00 for 1 dose of [REDACTED]! I had insurance but had not received my ID card because of some inexcusable mix-up @ the insurance company, another story, so I was charged the Charge Master prices. I called & spoke to the administrator of revenue cycle, & her answer to me was, "Well, all I can tell you is that is how it has been since I've been (employed) here." I told here that was not a good answer & that, being in medicine myself, & my [REDACTED] [REDACTED] her answer was not a solution to a HUGE problem. Did she not think \$1024 for a \$6 dose of medication was a bit out of line? That is just 1 example of many just on that bill alone. I might add that the invoice reached my home practically before I did!!
