Dear Ms. Bennett:

As you are aware, on July 17, 2015, I sent a letter to all Florida hospitals and managed care plans participating in Statewide Medicaid Managed Care to certify that they were meeting the provisions of s. 409.975(6), Florida Statutes, relating to hospital reimbursement levels. In my letter, I stated that failure to submit the requested certification by August 1, 2015 would be treated as acknowledgement of non-compliance with the request.



On August 3, 2015, Governor Scott asked me to direct the Office of Medicaid Program Integrity to audit all hospitals and plans that did not certify their compliance as of August 1. Pursuant to the Governor's request, I am asking that you develop an audit plan, including any and all applicable sanctions related to non-responsiveness, and commence the audit of the facilities listed above immediately, so we can determine that hospitals and insurance plans entered into contractual agreements that are fully compliant with state law.
